



Saturday 16th September 2017 - Lecture The origins of Wessex: Long Wittenham and the context of power in seventh century England

A talk given to the society by Adam McBride, Queen's College, Oxford

Adam came to talk on the rise to power of Saxon kings in the 6th and 7th centuries, mainly along the Upper Thames and even further into Buckinghamshire and Berkshire. His presentation was based on evidence from burials, settlements, and the ultimate early Saxon status symbol, the Great Halls of princes and tribal leaders

18th-22nd September 2017 Geophysical survey in Arborfield

Members of the society conducted a resistivity survey at Hall Farm to attempt to locate the former Arborfield Hall. Unfortunatey the building seems to have been thoroughly demolished and buried so little was found. Examination of old photographs enabled the team to conclude where it had probably been sited.




